## Liberty Weekend 2019

*January 3-5, 2019*

Liberty Weekend is a three-day program that explores the ideas of freedom and free enterprise. Students participate in discussions regarding democracy, individual rights, economics and law. The program is an interactive and enjoyable weekend that takes advantage of both the history and vibrancy of the City of Philadelphia and the Union League. The program will include a diverse platform of speakers, intellectual discussion and debate. Social activity and free time are built into the schedule to ensure you interact and connect with your peers.

The program runs from **Thursday, January 3** to **Saturday, January 5, 2019**. All attendees are required to attend and participate in the entire program, and must stay overnight at the Inn at the League. There are no costs associated with this program. Meals and lodging will be provided for the duration of the weekend.
